
JOB POSTINGS BY MONTH FOR SUDBURY-MANITOULIN AREA

How many job postings were active for at least 1 day this month?




NUMBER OF ACTIVE JOB BOARDS

How many job postings were active for at least 1 day this month on these job boards?




AVG & MEDIAN POSTING LENGTH BY DAYS


DEMAND BY KEY SECTOR (SUDBURY-MANITOULIN AREA)

How many job postings were active for at least 1 day this month by sector?















DEMAND BY IMPACTED SECTOR (SUDBURY-MANITOULIN AREA)








JOB POSTINGS BY JOB CATEGORY




What language skills are employers looking for by occupational skill level?










