

How many job postings were active for at least 1 day this month on these job boards?




AVG & MEDIAN POSTING LENGTH BY DAYS




DEMAND BY KEY SECTOR (SUDBURY-MANITOULIN AREA)




DEMAND BY IMPACTED SECTOR (SUDBURY-MANITOULIN AREA)










JOB POSTINGS BY JOB CATEGORY








